The Green Cross – Patient safety in practice

Daily dialog about healthcare injuries and/or healthcare near miss with the personnel.

Life supporting HMV (home mechanical ventilation) - a method for caring including advanced medical aids at home

Tour around the clinical training center (KTC)

The goal of the KTC is to strengthen the professional competence of our employees, this leads to increased security and thus contributes to increased patient safety. Our training is based on clinical everyday life and includes everything from training of basic skills to full-scale simulation.

Remote monitoring of pacemaker patients

The cardiac intensive care unit create value by monitoring hundreds of pacemaker patients remotely every day. The patients can be safe at home knowing the hospital is monitoring their hearts. See how the unit work with the technology and hear how they interact with the patients in their homes while the patients are carrying on with their daily lives.
