Daxi Tea Factory

Built in 1926, the Daxi Tea Factory covers an area of 1,670 square feet, and was formerly named the "Jiaoban Mountain Factory." It is hidden in some quiet alleys, and the architecture is a fusion of Taiwanese, Japanese, and British styles.

Daxi Bridge

The bridge was originally built in 1934 as a bamboo-wooden bridge constructed from bamboo frames and layered rocks. During the Japanese rule of Taiwan, the bridge was rebuilt into a dual-bored cable suspension bridge with a total length of 280 meters. After the opening of the nearby Wuling Bridge and Second Outer Ring Road, the bridge became gradually less used by the residents. It has seen been reconstructed twice due to the damage caused by typhoons. Lastly, the bridge was renovated again in 2001 after the planning from the Directorate General of Highways and its length became 330 meters.

Yingge Pottery Street

The main attraction in the town is Yingge Old Street, and is a pedestrian shopping street specializing in ceramic arts, pottery, porcelain, and other related products ranging all price points.

Yingge is the largest center for ceramic production in Taiwan, with over 800 ceramic-related businesses in the area around Yingge Old Street.

Yingge Ceramics Museum

New Taipei City Yingge Ceramics Museum opened on November 26, 2000 and is Taiwan's first ceramics-themed museum. It is dedicated to the research, curation, preservation, and maintenance of Taiwan's ceramics culture and art while performing work in exhibition and education. The Museum actively engages in international exchange by inviting international resident artists, joining the International Council of Museums, and becoming reciprocal museums with museums in Germany and Spain. Yingge Ceramics Museum is committed to bringing the beauty of Taiwan's ceramics to the world and showcasing the energy of Taiwan's ceramics culture and ceramic art.
