

## Experience Day 4: Quality Improvement in Traditional Chinese Medicine (Ko Da Pharmaceutical and Taipei City Hospital, Linsen Chinese Medicine and Kunming Branch)

Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM) is an established part of the healthcare system in Taiwan, funded by the government and covered by the National Insurance system for patients to access. In the 10 years following the introduction of the National Insurance system, it was estimated around 60% of patients accessed TCM at some point.

The visit will provide an overview of how patients access different services throughout their treatment journey and consider how that affects the delivery of person-centered care. It will also provide participants an opportunity to consider how quality improvement methods from TCM could be applied to Western medicine.

## Taipei City Hospital, Linsen Chinese Medicine and Kunming Branch

Linsen Chinese Medicine and Kunming Branch is one of the branches of the Taipei City Hospital. It provides the integrated healthcare service combining with both Western medicine and Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM). In terms of the TCM, Linsen Chinese Medicine and Kunming Branch is a well-known institute in both training and healthcare providing. It includes divisions of Internal Chinese Medicine, Chinese Medicine for Women, Pediatric Chinese Medicine, Acupuncture, and Traumatology in Chinese Medicine. The team also applies the traditional solar terms and the moxibustion therapy to establish a specialized clinic of "Acupoint Application". In addition, the hospital established the "Traditional Chinese and Western Medicine Healthcare Center", especially for gastroenterology & hepatology diseases, cancers, diabetes, cerebropathy, arthralgia, myalgia, etc. The aim is to apply the scientific method of Western evidence-based medicine along with the TCM diagnosis of "Observation Auscultation and Olfaction, Inquiry, Pulse Feeling and Palpation".
