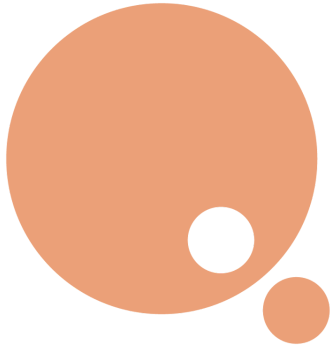


International Forum on QUALITY & SAFETY in HEALTHCARE UTRECHT

For Utrecht, we're interested in projects that demonstrate:

1. Co-production in action	We are looking for submissions that describe the method(s) of co-production used in real user-cases, then measuring and understanding the impact of doing co-production well
2. Advancing Equity	We are particularly looking for examples of improvement work that has led to demonstrable improvements to equity for staff, for patients and/or for communities
3. Health and wellbeing of staff	We are particularly looking to hear about scaled / scalable interventions that have been co-produced with staff and are demonstrating clear, sustained benefit. An example Samen leren - Health-Thing
4. Finding human-centred hope for the future	We are looking for ideas for human-centred sessions that are future looking, hopeful, and that attendees can go back to their work and lives and test / prototype / implement. This sub-topic to be led by early career professionals, and co-produced with participants who are attending.
5. Human and tech collaboration	The co-production of humans and technology. Exploring the intersection of human expertise and technological advancements e.g. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Human-centred design: How can technology be co-designed• AI and Healthcare; the ethical issues; the interfaces; acceptable standards (eg driverless cars example)• How can we actively use AI to improve equity, rather than worsen it• Can technology enable better co-production?
6. Metrics that matter	Getting serious about measurement around people, their experiences and their outcomes.
