




Breast cancer screening rate after the campaign

Only 38.5% of women aged 45-69 had mammograms from 2013 to 2014.

1.According to the cancer registry, the incidence rate of breast cancer ranks number one in 2012, and compared to ten years ago, there is an obvious increase. Even though the survival rate is high, the death rate is number four in cancers affected women, due to the low screening rate.

2.In order to lower the death rate, the government provides free mammograms for the groups of women with higher incidence rates. 1.498 million of women aged 45 to 69 had mammograms between 2013 to 2014 and the screening rate is 38.9%. Although the rate is still below 50%, it increases 30.9% compared to the rate from 2005 to 2006.




