





Take home messages

- 3. Understand the importance and relevance of **standardization of health information**








The Individual patient overview (IPÖ)





PROM – part of IPÖ and the overview







IPÖ structures data for caregiver and patient

Caregiver

- Preparation before and during meetings with the patient
- In internal meetings
- In preparation and during MDT-meetings
- Statistics and follow-up at the clinic
- Identification for patients clinical studies



Patient



- Is able to reach IPÖ through the national patient portal 1177
 Vårdguiden
- Is able to answer surveys (PROMs)
- Is able to see the interactive IPÖ overview



Development and implementation

Diagnostic common development

2012-2016

Development and test of pilot systems Kidney-, Prostate- and Lung cancer



2016-2018

Development of generic model and investigations of legal, tecnical and organisational aspects



2018-2020

Development of IPÖ för eight diagnoses quality management system

- Approx. 61 hospitals


Structured, directed interviews



Status

- IPÖ released for **eight cancer diagnoses** in 2020
- Approximately 60 000 patienter has a started IPÖ
- Scientific study- showing the reduction of the preparation time before meeting the patient to one third



- Benefits for many




Benefits when structured data can be compiled:

Integration between different systems


 Implementation of new innovations and systems
